- Registration (race weekend) accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express or cash only. No checks.
- To "finalize" race entry, Pre-Entry riders (to include parent/guardian/authorized adult if rider is a minor) MUST check in at Registration (Scoring Tower) to sign releases and get practice sticker before you will be allowed to practice or race.
- Two (2) notarized parental consent statements are needed for guardian/authorized adult to sign releases for minor.
- ALL RIDERS must be present at registration wearing wristband to register, sign releases and get practice sticker before you will be allowed on track to practice or race.
- If "Organized Practice" is in effect, you must practice with your designated group.
